PREAMBLE :

The Sri Ragalahalli Akkammajeera Muddanna Smaraka Educational & Charitable Trust, Tumkur, Karnataka had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to R.Muddurangegowda College of Education, Near Residency Public School, Jyothi Nagar, Sira Town, Tumkur District-512137, Karnataka for B.Ed Course on 30.12.2003.

After considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 30.11.2005 to the applicant institution under provisio to Section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

Further, applicant institution had submitted the written representation on 14.12.2005. The said representation was considered by the Regional Committee on 15-16 December, 2005, and the Committee decided to refuse recognition.

Accordingly, order of refusal was issued vide Ir.No.5107 dated.04.01.2006.

The applicant institution preferred appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, before NCTE, New Delhi. The Appellate Authority considering the appeal passed an order vide.F.No.89-50/2006-Appeal dated.26.09.2006 reversing the decision of SRC.

The order of Appellate Authority was placed before SRC in its meeting held during 120th meeting held on 3-4 November, 2006. The Committee decided to issue recognition order to the appellant institution from the session 2006-07.

Hence the order.

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Sri Ragalahalli Akkammajeera Muddanna Smaraka Educational & Charitable Trust, Tumkur, Karnataka** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to **R.Muddurangegowda College of Education, Near Residency Public School, Jyothi Nagar, Sira Town, Tumkur District-512137, Karnataka** for **Secondary(B.Ed) Course of one year duration** from the academic session **2006-07** with an annual intake of **100** students.

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On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3 lakhs.
- h. The institution has selected the Principal and Seven teachers for the said course

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **R.Muddurange Gowda College of Education, Near Residency Public School, Jyothi Nagar, Sira Town, Tumkur District-512137, Karnataka** for **Secondary (B.Ed)** course of **one year** duration from the academic session **2006-2007** with an annual intake of **100** students subject to fulfillment of the following.

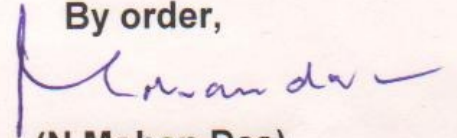
- a. The institution will ensure that Principal and Seven faculty members duly approved by DSERT are in position for an intake of **100** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.
- b. The institution shall, within three months of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
- c. The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
- d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

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4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Directorate of State Educational Research and Training (DSERT) to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
